



Horseback Riding Lessons

The Clara Barton Camp program offers horseback riding lessons **during two-week sessions only**. The lessons are held at a local riding stable within walking distance. Campers will receive 6 one-hour lessons throughout their camp stay in a ring setting with an instructor and volunteers. Campers will ride outside or inside, depending on the weather.

The cost for horseback riding lessons at Clara Barton Camp is \$250 per child in addition to the total camp fee. Spaces are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Spaces will not be reserved until full payment is received. There are only 16 spaces available per session so, if interested, we suggest that you register right away.

To reserve a space in horseback riding, fill out and return the following information with a payment of \$250. Please make checks payable to The Barton Center. Additional horseback riding enrollment forms and safety information will be mailed to you.
