- Ice Derby Rules -

1. Registration

- A \$20 registration fee is due upon arrival (registration table at boat ramp.)
- Children 12 and under fish for FREE
- All registrants are eligible for prizes and hourly drawings
- Proceeds go directly to Camp Joslin (camp for children with diabetes)

2. Contest Period/Fishing Guidelines

- The derby runs from 7am to 3pm
- No holes shall be drilled prior to 7am
- All lines must be up by 3pm sharp
- A maximum of 5 lines per angler (Tip ups & Jigging rods combined)
- A 2010 Massachusetts fishing license is required for entrants 15 years of age and older (see Mass Wildlife web site for license requirements)

3. Weighing Fish (Prizes to be awarded at 3pm or shortly after no sooner)

- Prizes (based on weight) will be for the following species ONLY: Largemouth/Smallmouth Bass, Yellow/White Perch and Pickerel
- Derby Directors will weigh your fish. They will be walking/riding around the pond flag them down if a weigh-in is needed.
- New digital scales will be used to weigh the fish ensuring accuracy.
- Entrants name, Fish species, weight (lbs + oz), and length will be recorded on the spot any ties (by weight) will determined by length of the fish
- ALL FISH are to be released alive immediately after weigh-in

4. On-The-Pond Communication

- All of the Derby Directors will have two way radios tuned in to Channel 5.
- If you need assistance and do not have a radio, then alert the nearest Derby Director (give 'em a holler!).
- You are allowed to use a temporary holding area (i.e. large bucket) to keep your fish alive until we can document/weigh it.

5. Drawings

- There will be a drawing each hour from 9:00 to 2:00. All Derby entrants are automatically eligible to win.
- The drawing prizes will be 5 gal Home Depot buckets containing assorted merchandise donated by our generous sponsors: Klem's, Polar Kraft, D & G Bait/Tackle, Okuma Fishing, Yamamoto Baits, Eagle Claw, Bomber, YUM, Booyah, and LCAC-TV.
- There will be several raffle items, including sporting event tickets, rod & reel combos, Charlie Moore merchandise, and assorted gift cards.
- Before you leave, check in at the registration table to see if you've won a prize

6. Derby Prizes
