Opening Day:

You will receive an email with your drop off time. **Upon arrival on opening day, everyone must wear masks on Opening Day. Parents must stay outdoors.** See COVID Protocols document for procedures on opening day. **FORMS MUST BE RETURNED TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL. CAMPER WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND CAMP WITHOUT ALL NECESSARY FORMS.**

Forms to be returned to the Camp Office as soon as possible but no less than two weeks before camp arrival

Please go to our website (<https://www.bartoncenter.org/registration/#scc>) to review all the **confirmation materials required for Vermont Overnight Camp**, download, print, fill out, and mail required forms to us. If you registered online, please see Forms section on your account dashboard—click on Download Forms tab to view all documents (mail to PO Box 356, North Oxford, MA 01537 or if you registered online you may upload to our online registration site using the Upload Forms tab):

- A copy of an annual physical exam form, COVID-19 vaccination card, and immunization record completed and signed by your child's physician. Must be completed **less than** 12 months from your child's last day of camp.
- Primary Health Care Provider Approval Form if no activity release included as part of physical exam.
- Copy of Camper's Insurance Card and Prescription Card
- Authorization to Administer Medication—Must be completed for each medication including insulin and glucagon, as well as all over-the-counter medications/vitamin supplements to be taken while at camp. Please make copies as appropriate.
- Signed last page of Camper Handbook (Handbook Agreement)
- COVID-19 Release
- Looping Waiver (if applicable)
- Parent Consent Form

Forms to be brought with you to camp on Opening Day:

- Pre-Camp Blood Sugar and Insulin Record—Record all blood glucose results and insulin doses given for the week prior to attending camp.
- Current Insulin Plan—Provide all dose information for all types of insulin taken including any special instructions.

- Camper Handbook (please mail the signed Handbook Agreement on the last page)
- 2022 COVID-19 protocols (Please check our website for any updates to protocols.)
- Bunk1 flyer
