If you registered online, please see Forms section on your account dashboard—click on Download Forms tab to view all documents. Forms may be mailed to PO Box 356, North Oxford, MA 01537, or if you registered online you may upload to our online registration site using the Upload Forms tab:

- A copy of an annual physical exam form, COVID-19 vaccination card, and immunization record completed and signed by your child's physician. Must be completed less than 12 months from your child's last day of camp.
- Primary Health Care Provider Approval Form signed by your child's physician if no activity release is included as part of physical exam form.
- Authorization to Administer Medication (Department of Public Health Form) Must be completed for each medication, and all over-the-counter medication/vitamin supplements, including **insulin, Glucagon**, etc. Please make copies as appropriate.
- Copy of Camper's Health Insurance Card and Prescription Card
- Signed last page of Camper Handbook (Handbook Agreement)
- COVID-19 Release
- Looping Waiver (if applicable)
- Parent Consent Form
- Horseback Riding Registration Sheet and payment (return only if your child will take horseback lessons—form must be mailed, cannot be uploaded to online registration site)
- CrossFit Classes Form and payment (Ages 12 & up - return only if your child will attend CrossFit classes—must be mailed—cannot be uploaded to online registration site)

Forms to be brought with you to camp on Opening Day:

- Pre-Camp Blood Sugar and Insulin Record—Record all blood glucose results and insulin doses given for the week prior to attending camp.
- Current Insulin Plan—Provide all dose information for all types of insulin taken including any special instructions.

- Open House Information (register online or send in registration form if you will be attending)
- Meningococcal Notice
